## FINAL Board Meeting Minutes – September 20, 2023 7:00 pm

## AGENDA

- 1. Review Agenda, Steve -- Meeting was held in-person and virtually at Tracy Landboe's house
- 2. Minutes No meeting was held in August.
- 3. Live Agenda, Committee Chairs
  - a. Finance, Gerrie Gerrie provided budget report at meeting and in subsequent email to Board dated 9/26 provided additional numbers for August. The strength of the camps increased revenue and gains in August over Budget, despite increased wages. We had a gain of \$7,445 and a Total Fund Balance of \$59,076. Enrollment in classes will go down in the next few months and no revenue from the Frostbite Camp this year. Estimates for the boathouse build-out are needed before any more large purchases like boats.
  - b. 2024 Budget, All Budget is due the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of October. Tami led discussion on likely 2024 expenses: Sorenson trailer, davet harness, safety launch (Sorensons cost \$500-\$2000), team boat upgrades, boats for larger kids, work out equipment updates (e.g., squat racks), truck account, race course maintenance including 2 lines of buoys (\$800) and 1 new stainless line (\$1700), race course storage (industrial shelving), finish line camera. Jason said that additional money should be budgeted for financial aid in 2024.
  - c. Fund Raising, All book sale at Thanksgiving
  - d. Sprint, Karla 7-8 paddlers on the development team, 6 paddlers went to Ridge race, there are more college paddlers
  - e. Regatta, John Eric Hughes regatta, information will be out in October
  - f. Boat House, Eli
  - g. Sprint Coaches Association report Eli
  - h. Membership / Adult, Liz
  - i. Communications / Web site / Newsletter, TBD Tami and Eli working on website, Peach Jar ads were a success

- Green Lake Small Craft Center Report, Tami Schedule currently shows the boathouse project being substantially complete on December 19<sup>th</sup>, with boathouse build-out to begin in mid-January. Tami reaching out to interior designer for design help for planning group – costs for build-out will includes interior painting, temporary wall, boat racks, changing areas
