- 5. Finance, Gerrie Total budget is \$33,661 . Below budget by \$1,045. Low on adult Membership compared to pre-covid levels
 - a. b. March course set up/take down not included, so may not be as behind as finances currently show
 - b. work on increasing membership and youth participation
 - c. ARC getting numbers out in 4th week of month
 - i. Raised question of moving board meeting to first of month

ACTION ITEM: Gerrie to send numbers out earlier (if possible), track when numbers are received from ARC for a few months and decide if moving board meeting to a different week would be beneficial

6. Fund Raising, All – Tami said need to plan for Ted Houk, Karla set date for garage sale (Saturday July 15th), Tami sent email to find out about day of/on site payments, more to follow

ACTION ITEM: Karla will organize bake sale (choose dates), Garage sale at Karla's house, Tami to work on purchasing Brown Bear tickets and Karla to get them to kids to start selling

- a. Brown bear car wash kids to sell tickets
- b. Bake sale set up near containers (preferred over community center so that sale is associated with SCKC): bottled water, Costco ice cream bars, and baked goods, lemonade
- C. Goal: raise \$5000 for nationals and Pacific Cup

- 7. Sprint team kids had great race over weekend (Slawko Fedechko) and home by Sunday, not many kids in the finals (scheduled late in day)
 - a. Approx. 12 kids on the team but only 6-7 going to Regattas
 - b. U23s also going so 9 racers total
- 8. Regatta, John Meeting on Saturday with Tami, Philip and John
 - a. Philip contacted coaches, making entries, expecting good attendance (San Diego, Calgary, etc.)
 - b. Crew timer improved
 - C. 2 stainless steel cables ordered already The cable cost has doubled to \$1290 per 1100 meter roll. We will also need \$160 for weighted rope. And cord for the buoys and stainless steel swages.
 - d. \$300 per lane for bouys

ACTION ITEM: order 72 yellow bouys for 2 lanes (Tami)

- e. Goal to improve 2 lines this year and then possibly 1-2 line per year after
 - i. Determine after next course setup how many lines need replaced
 - ii. Is the idea to mark the date on any new spools we buy so we know how old they are?

ACTION ITEM: 1. talk to RAC to increase funds for course maintenance - John, Tami, Steve subcommittee (figure out full cost of replacing a line and determine how frequently lines need to be replaced and work out budget for lane maintenance),

- f. Start labeling spools with date
- g. Need new spools

ACTION ITEM: reach out to Crispin to discuss/price new spools (John, Eli has email address)

- h. Annual Budget is \$1000 per year, Last purchase 2017, have \$2250 in pot
- i. Need people to prep bouys and cable line
 - i. Tammy is setting up the SignUp Genius for regatta volunteers
 - ii. Decide to do cables on shore vs on boats (or else need 2 boats)
 - iii. ACTION ITEM: figure out times/meeting place to prep bouys and cable
- 9. Boat House, Eli Has been doing some repairs, rudders order, surfski ordered, slowly improving maintenance on Tornados
 - a. Rack in North Container starting to tilt and a tornado fell off (damaged)
 - b. Bungees and extra magnets with hooks available Tami has in the office
 - C. Discussed ordering weedless rudder for tornado versus Soren's weed guard
 - d. Eli arranging demo boats (similar to Tornado) for mini- and masters

ACTION ITEM: secure kayak racks in containers

 Concrete pad should be started in next couple of weeks
 Steve Skogin thinks he can fix trailer on site, Tami to get formal quote (?)
